

THE CHINWAG SPECIAL – J VINCENT EDWARDS OF ‘HAIR’

Tune in to a very special hour of THE CHINWAG with host Jim Guynan, as he chats with J Vincent Edwards, famed for the musical Hair. Interviewed and recorded in April, 2017, in Ulm, Germany, where Edwards has lived for many years, Guynan catches all the best details about Edward’s life in music, so make sure you catch it too! The first broadcast is Sun. Oct. 22 at 7 pm, with a repeat on Thurs. Oct. 26 at 7 pm.

With Hair approaching its 50th anniversary -- and still going strong with a production at the Vaults in London – Edwards talks about his appearance in this ground-breaking musical, when it first appeared in London in 1968, and how it was shaped by the civil rights movement. Edwards also shares how he wrote the million-selling single ‘Right Back Where We Started From’ and how he played a role in the discovery of Jimi Hendrix.

Alongside his own hits, Edwards selects and plays the music that inspired and influenced him, including tracks by Dion, Sam Cooke, Rosie & The Originals, Ray Charles and Maurice Williams & The Zodiacs. He also reveals how his musical journey has seen him graduate from rhythm and blues with the South Shields outfit The Invictas, to freakbeat with The Answers, and soul as a solo artist.
